Opening Hours : 11am - 6pm on weekdays with classes

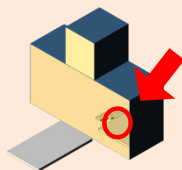

Instead, you can order to take out books from the book stack room via OPAC. The library staff will help you.
